Prayer Shawl: 5 x 5 Squares; DK Wool; 4 mm needles

Pattern for each square: Garter Stich



Cast on 3 stiches. Increase by one stich, at the beginning of each row by picking up from the row below, continue until you have 50 stiches. Now decrease by one stich at the beginning of each row, by winding wool over needle then knitting three together, continue until you have 3 stiches, then cast off.

Each Shawl is made up of 25 squares as above.
